Membership Privacy Policy

The Eurythmy Association of Great Britain and Ireland (EA) is a membership association and exists to provide support and information to its members and promote Eurythmy in the British Isles.

When you join the EA as a member we will assume that you have read and agree to this Privacy Notice, so please make sure you have read it in detail.

When you join the EA you will be asked to provide personal details such as name, address, email address and telephone number. You will also be required to make a membership payment, preferably via standing order or BACS transfer.

Personal information provided by you will not be shared with other organisations or individuals outside the Association and will be held jointly by the secretary, administrator, treasurer and website co-ordinator. We will not share your personal details with other members of the EA unless you have given explicit consent to this. Members who wish to make contact with another member of the EA can do so by asking either the secretary or treasurer to pass their email on to the person they wish to contact.

Financial information such as bank account details is held safely in our Business Bank Account and can only be accessed by the treasurer, administrator and the accountant for the EA. This information will never be used for any other purpose than identifying payments or making payments to you and it will never be shared with any other parties.

The EA will only use information provided by you in an appropriate written or electronic form. Information will be used to contact you about newsletters, events and activities of the Eurythmy Association or other news (national or international) that the Council consider support the aims of the Association.

Please tell us if you move or change contact details so we can keep your personal information up to date. You can request that your data be removed should you so wish by informing the Secretary.
